

CGS COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS UPDATED 14 OCTOBER 2022 - Term 4 2022

Week 2 onwards

Following a return to pre-pandemic norms, CGS has changed its current measures to reflect these changes and will continue to support staff and students in their own personal ongoing attendance of school and the workplace.

Where staff and students test positive for COVID-19

Continue to report all positive tests through CGS Connect.

- All students update the school through absences, staff through COVID-19 declaration form.
- Students and staff will need to remain at home for a minimum of 5 days¹
- All staff and students returning to school will need to wear a mask until the end of day 7².

RAT tests - Weekly staff RAT testing is no longer required. A further RAT Test will be provided to staff and students at the end of Term 4 as a Day 1 RAT test for the start of Term 1 2023.

Students who have signs and symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent to the health clinic and parents contacted.

Masks - will no longer be required but will be encouraged for large indoor gatherings. They will remain mandatory on school transport for Term 4

Household Contacts no longer need to inform the school or the ACT. Masks are still required to be worn at school

Vaccination - The school continues to strongly recommend students and staff maintain their vaccination and booster status

Density Requirements and Social Distancing - no restrictions

Parents on site - open access pre-covid. Parents who have tested positive to COVID-19 should follow the ACT current guidelines

Travel - School Trips, teams and travel will be assessed case by case.

Ventilation - should be encouraged and maintained wherever possible

Camp - RAT testing of staff and students prior to departure. Students who test positive for COVID-19 whilst away on camp will need to return home. Students who have COVID-19 cannot attend Camp.

Hygiene, cleaning, and signage - no further signs and hygiene and cleaning continue as normal

Exams - Staff must RAT test prior to their first day of work. Students and staff wear masks on entry to exams. Students and Staff can remove masks once sat down. Desks set up socially distanced from each other to allow removal of masks. Masks to be replaced when staff and students need to leave their desks.

Boarding House students and staff will continue to test on Sunday night but only for the duration of Term 4. Students that test positive will be removed from boarding for a minimum of 5 days or until signs and symptoms disappear.

Term 1 2023 - All are reminded that COVID-19 cautions maybe reapplied in Term 1 depending on conditions at the time.

¹ This is in line with previous recommendations in the ACT

² Primary School students are exempt from wearing masks. The school encourages mask wearing where possible.
