From here, the children will be escorted by CGS Care educators to the area where their activity will commence.

At the completion of each day's activity, the children will be provided with a light afternoon tea on the terrace at the Southside building, this occurs at 3:00pm. Children can be collected from this location until 3:30pm. Educators then separate children into their respective programmes for the remainder of the afternoon in the International Centre.

CYANOTYPE PRINTING

Cyanotype photography is a camera-less technique that involves laying an object on paper coated with a solution of iron salts before exposing it to UV light and washing with water to create stunning white and Prussian blue images. During this workshop you will be invited to create your own Cyanotype image that will be transferred onto a cotton tote bag as well as create smaller designs onto squares of plain fabric.
