BATH BOMBS

Making bath bombs is a hands-on activity that combines creativity with basic science. Each child will get to mix simple ingredients, that are often found in most kitchens, like baking soda, citric acid and essential oils to create colourful fizzy bath bombs that can be taken home to enjoy or gift.

This process encourages teamwork, how to follow instructions and measuring skills all while sparking curiosity about chemical reactions. It's a great way for children to explore scents and colours while expressing themselves artistically and then getting to enjoy the satisfaction of making their own bath bombs.
